## 03. WINPOL | How can waste management benefit from the use of information and data?



On 14 May 2019, the first of series of seminars on innovation in

the waste field kicked off in the framework of the WINPOL project. Hosted by Snaga, the public waste management company of the City of Maribor, it focused on the collection and use of information to optimise waste management. It gathered project partners and their local stakeholders to exchange relevant good practices existing on their territories. Additional experiences, including from ACR+ member LIPOR, were brought by external experts invited by ACR+, the Advisory Partner of the project. The presentations of the more than 10 practices exchanged are available on the event website. The seminar already counts with successful outcomes as several partners and experts identified external concrete possibilities for collaboration and will continue bilateral exchanges.

In the following months, partners will continue identifying good practices in preparation of the second thematic seminar focusing on innovative models for collection, prevention and recycling in Antwerp in late Autumn 2019. In the meantime, local actors in the partners' territories can get involved in the WINPOL project through a series of events organised by the partners.
